I Am Not Ashamed

We all make mistakes. But, what happens when we believe that we ARE a mistake? Too many women carry condemnation because of what they've been through or because of something that they've done. We'll use God's Word to diagnose and learn how to demolish four different kinds of shame and practical steps to walk in the freedom of forgiveness in Christ. (Theme: Identity, Forgiveness from Guilt or Shame)

Mirror, Mirror: Seeing Yourself as God Sees You

Does God care if you look in the mirror and hate what you see? Poor body image is the #1 driver of shame in women, including Christian women. We'll use God's Word to learn how to see ourselves as God sees us. There are three biblical keys to help us win our ugly struggle with beauty once and for all! (Theme: Identity in Christ)

Becoming a Woman that C.A.R.E.S.

Why do women go overboard taking care of everyone in their lives, but feel guilty for taking care of themselves! Neglecting ourselves leaves us tired and run down with little desire to connect with God or others. Using 1 Peter 5:7 as a foundation, Barb will share the five areas where women often neglect themselves and she cast a vision for a Biblical model of self-care that helps us live for the glory of God, to benefit others and be a blessing to ourselves. (Theme: Self-Care)

Overcoming Our Labels to Live Our Legacy

How many of us carry baggage from the past – or even the present – that keep us from having hope for the future? We'll look at the story of Rahab and discover how God transformed her destiny. There are three lessons from her story that will help us escape the labels that lie to us and unlock God's legacy for our lives. (Theme: Identity in Christ & Forgiveness)

Hungry No More: Surrendering ourselves to the only ONE that satisfies!

Our culture over-consumes everything but God! We over-eat, over-spend, over-worry and most of us probably over-do social media. Yet, we're starved for peace, hope, and joy. What could happen if God's daughters truly hungered for the gifts only God can provide? We'll talk about how surrender weans us of the things that junk up our hearts, minds, bodies and souls. Barb will fill your spiritual plate with three daily opportunities to satisfy your soul in Christ! (Theme: Spiritual Discipline/Discipleship)

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Booking Information - Speaking Fees, Travel & More

Speaking Fees/Honorarium

SPEAKING FEE - LOCAL EVENTS

(within 100 miles of residence)

- 1 day with single presentation - \$1000
- 1 day with 2-3 presentations - \$1500
- 2 days with up to 4 presentations - \$2000
- 3 days with up to 5 presentations - \$2500

SPEAKING FEE - NON-LOCAL EVENTS

(More than 100 miles from residence or events that require air travel)

- 1 day with single presentation - \$1300
- 1 day with 2-3 presentations - \$1800
- 2 days with up to 4 presentations - \$2200
- 3 days with up to 5 presentations - \$2600

So how do speakers determine their fees? That's a great question! Just as your church's budget includes health insurance, office supplies, printing, professional fees, advertising and training, Christian speakers incur similar costs. Additionally, speakers have labor costs associated with developing presentations, creating resource materials, administrative tasks, phone calls, rehearsal, travel, and participation at your event.

If you are a new event planner or you are overwhelmed by budgeting, ask me for a copy of my free event planner. I've managed finances for both small and mega-budget women's events and I've got helpful tools to share with you.

Travel, Lodging & Meals

1. PAYMENT: Hosting church or organization is responsible for payment of speaker's travel expenses (including transportation, lodging and meals).
2. MILEAGE/AIR TRAVEL: Speaker will drive up to 200 miles to a speaking engagement. If driving, 2017 Federal mileage rates will apply (\$.535). For engagements over 200 miles away from speaker's residence, air travel will be necessary. Speaker's preferred airport is Detroit-Wayne Metro (DTW). Air travel should be booked by hosting organization at least one month prior to speaking engagement. Please contact speaker before booking to confirm travel dates, times and airline. Ground transportation by hosting organization must include at least one adult female at all times. *No mileage expenses for events less than 60 miles.
3. HOTEL BOOKING: If speaking engagement is 100 or more miles away from speaker's residence or speaker's arrival time is scheduled before 8am, a hotel reservation may be requested. Speaker requires hotel with interior room entrances and prefers hotel brands similar to Marriott, Hilton Garden Inn, Holiday Inn Express, Country Inn & Suites or Residence Inn. Hotel rooms should be prepaid in advance.
4. FOOD PREFERENCES/ALLERGIES: No allergies. Preferred choices: fresh chopped fruit, salads, water, Kind Bars and soft cookies. Preferred restaurants: Mexican, seafood, Chipotle and Chick-fil-A.

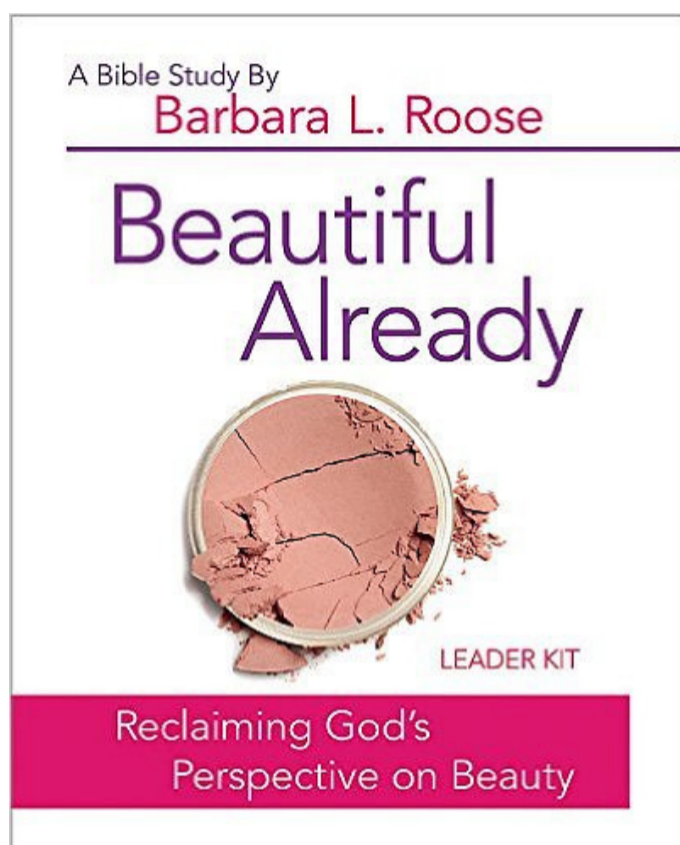

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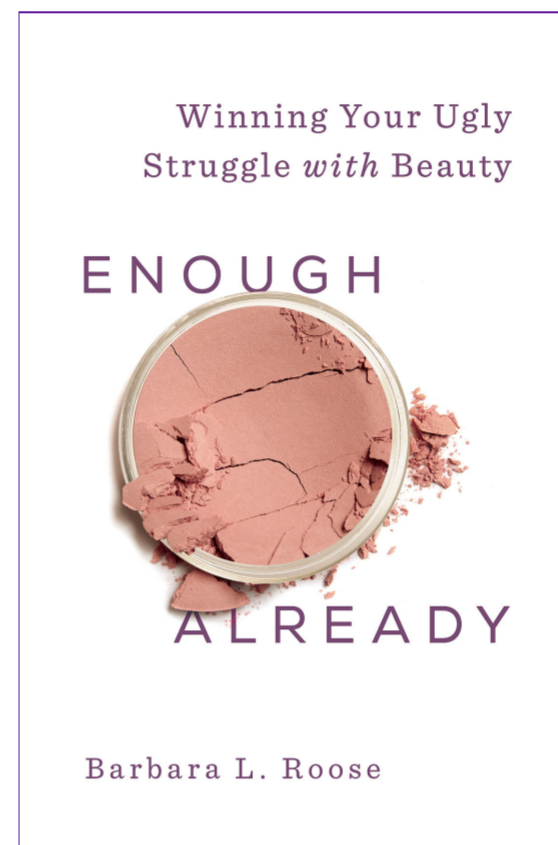
